I refer to your email (reference 10026-498e4deb) dated the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2009, requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 regarding the privatisation of the Cabinet Office Guard Service at Admiralty House.

The requests that we are receiving from you: have become excessive; are an unreasonable burden on and distraction to staff; and are seriously distracting a significant number of our staff from other work. In view of this, we have decided that Section 14(1) of the Act (which provides that we are not obliged to comply with a request for information which is vexatious) applies to this request. We will not therefore be processing your request for the above information any further.
