following upload , if a patient chooses to opt out , their record is made unavailable

for clinical use . It is however archived so that it can be retained for medico legal purposes since a clinician may have made a clinical judgement based upon its presence.

If a patient subsequently changes their mind and asks to have a SCR once more the archived record is made available once again but any missing time period can only be covered by asking the GP to send a refresh that could potentially cover the missing period. No other documentation is stored during the opt out period.

Siobhan will you send Ian any official material we have within the SCR team that delineates this our official position.

Dear Gillian/Marlene

We are dealing with a Freedom of Information Act 2000 request for correspondence between us and DoH/CfH about how patients can request the deletion of their personal data from a SCR **after** it has been uploaded. When we held a teleconference in August last year and you outlined the new consent model for us I have a note of that meeting making it clear that when a patient is asked for consent by a GP etc to **access** their SCR one of the choices they have is to request that SCR is deleted in its entirety. As I recall it this was a choice they could exercise if they were unaware (despite local publicity, letters to individual patients etc) that their personal data had been uploaded to create a SCR in the first place and, now having become aware that this had happened, they made it clear that they did not want a SCR at all.

Could you please confirm my understanding of this situation and tell me where (presumably on the DoH/CfH website?) I can find published confirmation of this arrangement, thank you?
