Thank you for your request for an internal review of our decision on your request F09-168.

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) entitles individuals to request access to information that is held by a public authority. In response to such requests, public authorities are obliged to confirm or deny whether that information is held (section 1, FOIA). If the information is held, the public authority must disclose that information, unless exemptions apply (section 2, FOIA).

You asked how many members of the RSPB are also Members of the House of Lords and the House of Commons. The House of Commons will only hold this information if a Member of the House of Commons has provided it for the Register of Members' Interests, and a link to this Register has already been sent to you. The House of Commons does not hold any further information in relation to this enquiry.
