Marie, in your capacity as East Kent LSP Partnership Support Officer and
Mark, in your capacity as contact for Kent Leisure Chiefs (KALCO):

I am sending you this on behalf of Caroline Davis who is Head of Strategic Partnerships for NHS Eastern and Coastal Kent (previously PCT). Unfortunately, Caroline will be away from work for a few weeks and has asked me to progress the issue of free places in swimming pools as per the government's offer to local authorities.

You may already be aware that the PCT has indicated it will consider contributing to any identified shortfall in funding for both the over 65's and under 15's initiatives. To that end we need figures from each authority that has flagged a predicted shortfall in order to consider the contribution that can be made. These figures need to be know As soon as possible please.

There have been possible figures emailed around for Dover, Swale, Canterbury, but not Ashford, Shepway or Thanet.

The Swale figure is already known, but we need figures for Thanet and Shepway and confirmation of the 'bandied' figures for Canterbury and Dover.

Our Chief Executive, Ms Ann Sutton has been approached by the East Kent LSP on this issue hence I would like to assume Marie that you can respond on behalf of Canterbury, Shepway, Dover and Thanet; and that you Mark can assist with Ashford information.

The information to hand is as follows:

Swale – shortfall identified and funding agreed by PCT.

Canterbury – David Ford has suggested that Canterbury will be alright for the over 65's initiative but predict a shortfall on under 15s – no figure given

Ashford – no information at all

Shepway – no information at all

Dover – The CE Nadeem Aziz has indicated a shortfall on £5k per annum on over 65's and a further £160K per annum on under 15s. Total of £165K PA

Thanet – no information at all
