The present situation at Dover is that we took a report to Cabinet on Monday 1 September and in order to buy a little more time it was agreed that the decisions to participate (or not) be delegated to the Leader, Portfolio Holder and the Head of Property, Leisure and Waste Management.

In terms of finance, the Govt's grant aid offer re the 60 and over age group is only a tad lower than the estimated loss of income so I suspect we will participate.

I'm less confident that the grant aid offer re the 16 and under age group will be sufficient to enable participation.

I'm just back from holiday but will be looking further into this over the next few days in respect, for example, of possible PCT top up monies, KCC stance, clarification re POT 3 and one or two other aspects (which I'm sure you will all have been considering).

Finally I would mention that our Leader has asked for the item to be placed on the agenda at the Kent Leaders Group mtg next week.

I will be happy to provide a further update in due course.
