Hi Kevin,

The position at Ashford is similar to Rob's i.e. that we (and I believe all districts) have now signed up to Kent Agreement 2, which includes NI8 in equal parts.

The next stage will be for the 8 District level LSPs to prepare and agree what are known as Local Area Plans. These are the 'district chapters' of the LAA and can be derived from the 35 indicators or be something different, if a local priority or issue is important enough to warrant it. The guidance from Kent Partnership is that districts should look at those KA2 indicators that are either a local priority or those where a particular district has performed less well compared to the other Kent districts, as a starting point. However, if there are other local issues that have been identified through the preparation of a Sustainable Community Strategy for example, then these can be picked up here too.

The Kent Partnership has requested that Local Area Plans are drafted by October, but this process will have to be facilitated by district level LSPs - I am the lead on the Ashford LSP and will be preparing something for the September meeting, so it is a little premature to be able to confirm what those local priorities will be.

In Ashford the priority is not likely to be adult participation in sport, but rather children and young people and wider social inclusion issues in participation. Christina can also provide you with further information relating to the Kent District Community Development Managers Group, a group of officers that has met regularly since the first Kent Agreement to monitor and manage indicators 7 and 13 of KA1, which might have a better handle on this.

I'll be at KALCO next week if you have any further queries on this.
