Internal Review-FO9-212

Thank you for your request for an internal review of our decision on your request FO9-212.

The Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) entitles individuals to request access to information that is held by a public authority. In response to such requests, public authorities are obliged to confirm or deny whether that information is held (section 1, FOIA). The House of Commons does not hold the information you requested.

The information you have requested appears to relate to correspondence between a London Borough and a Member of Parliament. Such information may be held by the Member of Parliament as an individual, but the House of Commons as a public authority does not hold information of this sort.
