Dear Sir or Madam,

Under the freedom of information act i wish to know.

1: How many serving police officers in 2008 in West Yorkshire have been convicted of a criminal offence?

2: How many serving police officers in 2008 in West Yorkshire have been cautioned for a criminal offence.

As ALL cautions and convictions have to be declared on their application forms including driving offences i would find it reasonable to have this information recorded.

By not providing this data I would suggest that you have lost the moral authority to Police West Yorkshire.

Your request will now be considered and you will receive a response within the statutory timescale of 20 working days as defined by the Act, subject to the information not being exempt or containing a reference to a third party. In some circumstances West Yorkshire Police may be unable to achieve this deadline. If this is likely you will be informed and given a revised time-scale at the earliest opportunity.

In exceptional circumstances, there may be a fee payable for the retrieval, collation and provision of the information you have requested. If this is the case you will be informed and the 20 working day timescale will be suspended until we receive payment from you. If you chose not to make a payment then your request will remain unanswered.
