Dear Ms Shrive

I am writing in response to your email of 30 May 2009 requesting a review of this office's handling of your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act. Under our internal complaints procedures your request has been passed to me to review. I have now reviewed our handling of your original request for information on 29 May 2009, the response you were sent on 29 May 2009 by Liz Hannan, and your subsequent emails of 5 July 2009 and 9 July 2009.

As I understand it, on 29 May you sent this office an email titled Freedom of Information Request - Collusion and Civil rights abuse. The content of this email contained a freedom of information request that you had raised with the Office for Judicial Complaints. In her response to you on 29 May Liz Hannan sought clarification from you about what specific information you were seeking from this office. In your email of 30 May you have sought a review of Liz Hannan's response.

I have considered your email of 29 May and I am satisfied that Liz Hannan's handling of your request has been entirely appropriate. I am afraid that it is still unclear as to whether you are seeking information from the Parliamentary and Health Service Ombudsman, and if so what that is. If you do want something from us and can specify it more clearly then please let us know. Alternatively, if you want to make a complaint to us about a body within our jurisdiction, then I have enclosed our leaflets explaining the procedures you need to follow.

I am sorry that we cannot help you further on this matter at this time. If you remain dissatisfied with our handling of your request for information or with my response you can refer the matter to the Information commissioner for review. He can be contacted at:
