## REVIEW OF REQUEST UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000

Thank you for your email of 14 July 2009 in which you asked for an internal review of our response to your request for information of 26 June 2009. In your request you asked for information about meetings between the between the Prime Minister's Office and 121Media between 1st January 2007 and 30th June 2007.

I have carefully reviewed the handling of your request. Having fully reconsidered this case I have concluded that I should uphold the decision given to you by the Cabinet Office in our letter of 26 June 2009.

I believe the request was properly considered. Our response of 26 June explains that the Cabinet Office would not be able to determine whether we hold the information you requested, locate it, and retrieve it within the appropriate limit. Our letter of 26 June offered advice on how you might re-frame your request in such a way as to bring it below the cost limit.
