REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

We refer our previous correspondence in relation to this enquiry, specifically our initial response dated 1 July 2009 and our most recent letter to you dated 11 August 2009.

Please find attached the ODA's initial tranche of information relating to Construction Hotline Call logs from January 2009 – May 2009 (**Annex A**). Please note that on many occasions the ODA has replaced caller names with the word "caller" and the names of the External Relations team who responded to an enquiry with the words "External Relations Team".
