THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES (ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC PLACES) REGULATIONS 2001

REDBRIDGE CONTROLLED DRINKING ZONE

The Council of the London Borough of Redbridge hereby gives notice that at the full Council meeting on the 17th July 2003 it designated a Controlled Drinking Zone in Redbridge pursuant to the above legislation:

1. The Council intends to introduce a Controlled Drinking Zone in central Ilford from the 4th August 2003.
2. The Controlled Drinking Zone is intended to cover all or part of the following streets:-

Aldborough Road South; Ardleigh Mews (off Bengal Road); Audrey Road; Balfour Road; Beal Road; Belmont Road; Buckingham Road; Cameron Road; Centreway; Chadwick Road; Chapel Road; Clarks Road; Clements Lane; Clements Road; Cleveland Road; Connaught Road; Coventry Road; Cranbrook Road; Elgin Road; Elizabeth Avenue; Francis Road; Francis Street; Green Lane; Grosvenor Road; Hainault Street; Handford Road (off Winston Way); Havelock Street; High Road; High Road (Seven Kings); Highbury Gardens; Holstock Road; Ilford Hill; Ilford Lane; Janice Mews (off Oakfield Road); Kenneth More Road (off Oakfield Road); Mildmay Road (off Winston Way); Mill Road; New Road; Northbrook Road; Oakfield Road; Park Avenue; Pembroke Road; Postway Mews (off Clements Road); Pymont Road (off High Road); Reads Close (off Chapel Road); Riches Road; Richmond Road; Riverdene Road; Roden Street; Seven Kings Road; St Albans Road; St Mary's Road; Station Road; Sunnyside Road; Sylvan Road (off Hainault Street); The Drive; Thompson Close (off High Road); Wellesley Road; Wilton Road (off Ilford Lane); Winston Way; Woodlands Road; York Road.

The specific parts of those streets to be included in the designated Controlled Drinking Zone are shown on a plan deposited at the First Stop Shop, Ground Floor, Lynton House, Ilford which may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours.

3. The effect of making the designated area a Controlled Drinking Zone will allow a Police Constable to require a person to cease drinking alcohol from an open container in a public place within the zone, and to surrender any such container holding intoxicating liquor. A person who fails to comply with the requirements of the constable may be arrested and may be subject to a maximum penalty at court of a £500 fine.
