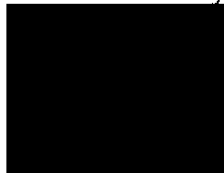

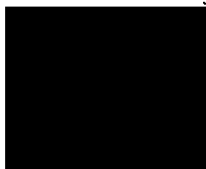

### **Communications Allowance**

Thank you for your recent Comms2 claim form, on which was attached an invoice for Buttermountain relating to your constituency website.

A booklet, detailing the administrative procedures relating to this allowance, was sent to all Members. May I draw your attention to Para 7, Page 27 states that your website must not *"advance perspectives or arguments with the intention of promoting the interests of any person, political party or organisation you support, or damaging to the interests of any other such person, party or organisation"*. The 'Latest News' section of your site contains an article titled 'Djanogly to petition Downing Street on Post office closures', which contains comments of a party political nature. This is not allowable on a website supported by public funds.

The 'Photos' section of your page also contains a picture of yourself with David Cameron, which may give undue publicity to the leader of a political party. This should also be removed.

I would be grateful if the required changes to your website could be made as soon as possible. Should you have any queries on this matter, or any other aspect of the Communications Allowance, please do not hesitate to contact me.

**Communications Allowance**

I refer to the letter my colleague, [REDACTED] sent to you on 16 October in response to your letter of 14 October.

On submission of your most recent invoice from Buttermountain the home page of your website was reviewed to ensure the content fell within the rules and guidelines governing the Communications Allowance.

We noted that, despite our previous request, the image of David Cameron still does not appear in context. You kindly explained in your letter that Mr Cameron visited the constituency. To avoid the potential impression of promoting your party leader we suggest that you add a caption notifying the reader of Mr Cameron's visit.

*The Members Estimate Committee Review of Allowances Third Report of Session 2007-08 (HC 578-I) states at Page 40, Para 140 states that 'Photographs which include other elected office-holders with the MP will be permitted, but captions should be purely factual and should not actively promote such people.'*
