**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTIONS 64 AND 65
AUTHORISATION OF TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SPECIAL DIRECTIONS**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers under Sections 64 and 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, for the purpose of informing road users of parking restrictions in Montague Road and Yorke Street Hucknall, Nottinghamshire, hereby:-

1. authorises the erection at or within 5 metres of the sites marked with pink stars on the attached schedule of plans numbered GT46/2/233(Pt1)-8 of a traffic sign (hereinafter referred to as "the authorised sign") conforming as to size, colour and character with that shown on the attached drawing numbered GT46/2/233(Pt1)-7, save that the times and days may be varied; and
2. directs that the authorised sign shall be used with the road marking shown in diagram 1028.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002 (Part I of SI 2002/3113); and
3. directs that, notwithstanding the provisions of Direction 25(1) of the Traffic Signs General Directions (Part II of SI 2002/3113), the road marking shown in diagram 1028.4 may be used with the authorised sign; and
4. directs that it is a condition of this authorisation that the authorised sign may be placed only to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Regulation Order; andGT46/2/233

5. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the erection of the authorised sign shall only be placed to indicate the effect of a corresponding Traffic Order; and
6. directs, without prejudice to any statutory provision to the like effect, that it is a condition of this authorisation that the placing of the authorised sign at or near the said sites shall continue to have effect only until such day as may be appointed by one month's notice given by the Secretary of State in writing to the traffic authority for the removal or alteration of the authorised sign and on that day the said authorisation shall, without prejudice to the giving of any further authorisation or direction, cease to have effect.

The provisions of Regulations 12, 17, 18 and 19 of the 2002 Regulations shall apply to the authorised sign in the same manner as they apply to the sign shown in diagram 639.1B in Schedule 2 to those Regulations.]

This authorisation replaces the earlier one dated 8 February under reference GT46/2/233 which is hereby revoked.
