NOTES:-

- Existing Limited Waiting Bay between points A and B to be converted to new Residents' Only Parking Bay and should accommodate approx. 4 vehicles
- New Double Yellow Lines (No Waiting At Any Time) Restriction to be introduced between points B and C to protect vehicular accesses
- Existing Limited Waiting Bay between points C and D to be converted to new Residents' Only Parking Bay and should accommodate approx. 16 vehicles
- New Double Yellow Lines (No Waiting At Any Time) Restriction to be introduced between points D and E to protect vehicular accesses
- Existing Limited Waiting Bay between points E and F to be converted to new Residents' Only Parking Bay which will be extended to point G and should accommodate approx. 3 vehicles
- New Double Yellow Lines (No Waiting At Any Time) Restriction to be introduced between points G and H and between points J and K to protect junction of Yorke Street and Derbys Lane
- Existing Single Yellow Line Waiting Restriction - No Waiting, 8am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday - between points K and L to be amended to No Waiting, 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday and new Part-Time Residents' Only Parking Bay (as specified below) will be introduced which should accommodate approx. 2 vehicles
- New Double Yellow Lines (No Waiting At Any Time) Restriction to be introduced between points L and M to protect vehicular accesses
- Existing Single Yellow Line Waiting Restriction - No Waiting, 8am to 6:30pm Monday to Saturday - between points M and N to be amended to No Waiting, 8am to 6pm Monday to Saturday and new Part-Time Residents' Only Parking Bay (as specified below) will be introduced which should accommodate approx. 13 vehicles
- New Double Yellow Lines (No Waiting At Any Time) Restriction to be introduced between points Q and R to tie in with existing Double Yellow Lines
- In addition, new double yellow lines (no waiting at any time) restriction to be introduced to protect junction of Central Avenue and Derbys Lane
- The new Residents' Only Parking Bays shown in RED will only operate 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- The new Part-time Residents' Only Parking Bays shown in BLUE will only operate between the following times:-
 - Sunday / Monday mid-night to Monday 8am
 - Monday 6pm to Tuesday 8am
 - Tuesday 6pm to Wednesday 8am
 - Wednesday 6pm to Thursday 8am
 - Thursday 6pm to Friday 8am
 - Friday 6pm to Saturday 8am
 - Saturday 6pm to Sunday / Monday mid-night
- The amended Single Yellow Line prohibiting waiting between 8am and 6pm Mondays to Saturdays shown in CYAN will apply to all vehicles, including vehicles with permits
- The extents of the Residents' Only Parking Scheme (and the properties to be entitled to a residents' or business permit in addition to visitors' permits) is shown by a continuous RED line
- Existing Single and Double Yellow Lines Waiting Restrictions which will be unrefracted by the introduction of the Residents' Only Parking Scheme are shown in ORANGE
