### **Ice Cream Stall: "Street Trading"?**

In a previous email to you I referred to the setting up of an ice-cream stall on the tow path as part of this business. I attach a photograph.

I note this seems to now be located on the boat, it may be that your officers have already dealt with this matter?

I note an "A-Board" still remains on the tow-path re the sale of ice-cream, this adds to the image of this being a cafe/restaurant and not that "*any sale of food or drink shall be purely ancillary to the stated purpose*".

### **Setting Up and Operation of TakeAway Business on Tow Path area on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2009**

On the day of the "Great River Race" Greedies set up a takeaway business on the grass by the tow path. This offered a "Roast Hog on a spit". This consisted of various tables for serving, including salad, burger buns etc. till operation, supply of power from the boat and bottled gas.

Was permission given for this street trading business?

I note the planning condition re "no sale of takeaway hot food" relating to these premises.

### **Sale of Alcohol**

I have heard on the "Richmond grapevine" that the Greedies business on the boat offers a "Bring Your Own" ("BYO") service.

On Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> September this business was supplying wine to many of the tables of customers. I attach photographs. I do not believe these various customers brought this wine with them.

I noted that most of the customers seemed to be placing the wine bottles on the deck (floor) rather than have them visible on tables. Slightly unusual behaviour unless encouraged to do so?

On Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> September, beer was also being offered for consumption on the riverside as part of the "TakeAway Business" discussed above.

This beer was being stored in a large bin with ice and water in the same manner that perhaps you or I would do if we were having a large BBQ in a garden.

Was a TEN issued for these activities re sale of alcohol?
