- 6) How many drivers are there in London with a full UK drivers license aged 21-70 and are registered vehicle keepers?**
- 7) How many drivers in the London holding a full UK drivers license are Males AND how many are Females?**
- 8) How many drivers are there in London with a full UK drivers license aged 18-20?**

The attached Excel spreadsheet provides details of all full licence holders by age and by gender with separate figures for London and the rest of Great Britain. It is not possible to know how many licence holders are also vehicle keepers since there is no cross reference between the drivers and vehicles databases. All driver records are held under name, date of birth and address, while all vehicle records are held under the registration number of the vehicle.
