Freedom of Information Act Request Reference N⁰: FOI 665/09

I write in connection with your request for information, which was received by the Norfolk Constabulary on the 23rd of November 2009. I note you seek access to the following information:

1. *How many arrests have been made as a result of racially aggravated offences in each of the last five years (2004 to 2009)?*
2. *What were the reasons for these arrests and how many arrests were made for each offence?*
3. *How many of these arrests resulted in convictions in court?*

Your request will now be considered in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act (2000). You will receive a response within the statutory timescale of 20 working days, as defined by the Act, subject to the information not being exempt or containing a reference to a third party.

In advance of our response, I would like to point out that the Freedom of Information Act provides the public with a right to request access to recorded information held by the Constabulary. If any of the information you have requested is not contained in a recorded format, the Constabulary is not obliged to create information for the purpose of responding to your request.

We aim to respond to your request by the **22nd of December 2009**. In some circumstances the Norfolk Constabulary may be unable to achieve this deadline. If this is likely, you will be informed and given a revised timescale at the earliest opportunity.
