Thanks very much for the contract for locum services. As mentioned I am emailing the key elements of the contract.

Two reasons for this. Firstly to act as a record and secondly I am hoping you will agree to confirm these terms to [REDACTED]

Hours: 25 hours a week over three days

Hourly rate: £50

Employment status: I will be self employed or provide the services through a solicitors practice

P I Insurance: I will be covered by the Council's insurance for professional indemnity

Expenses: the cost of two nights accomodation will be paid by the Council

Start date: 28th May 2007

Location: most of the work will be undertaken at the Council's offices

Parking: a parking permit will be provided by the Council

I hope this reflects our discussions.
