Your request for information

I am sorry about the delay in replying to your e-mail of 13th April 2010 in which you seek further information in relation to the prosecution of Chief Inspector Jamie Jones of the West Midlands Police.

My responses to each of your questions are as follows:

1. The breathalyser test was carried out at approximately 02:25 hours by the attending officers.
2. Mr Jones accompanied the officers to the police station on a voluntary basis. He was arrested later that morning at 09:20.

If you are not satisfied with this response you may request an independent internal review by our FOI appeals officer, who has had no involvement in dealing with your request. If you wish to complain about any aspect of this decision, please contact:
