A number of children may have ceased to live in the family setting in which they were considered to be harmed due to:

- parents separating
- families deciding on different kinship or extended family care arrangements
- voluntary accommodation for their children

There may have been court proceedings and voluntary accommodation or proceedings and specialist assessments that identified changes, but information is not aligned in our systems to provide this breakdown without extensive work.
