Note 1: As you asked for personal information about another person we are required by section 40(2) of this act to take into account the principles of the Data Protection Act 1998. Upon consideration and in light of recent decision notices by the Office of the Information Commissioner, we have determined that release of these names would be unfair to those persons and therefore incompatible with the first Principle of the Data Protection Act 1998. 
