Dear Ms Snook,

Your request was received on 15 January 2010 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

You asked:

*“Could you tell me how many people visited the Museum of Classical Archaeology each month in the year up to the closure of the Museum?”*

We do not hold information about the number of visits, by month, to the Museum of Classical Archaeology; we hold information only on a yearly basis. There were 5262 visits to the Museum of Classical Archaeology in the year prior to its temporary closure on 12 June 2009.
