THE HERTFORDSHIRE (A10 GREAT CAMBRIDGE ROAD, CHESHUNT)
(40 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2009

The Hertfordshire County Council in exercise of their powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "The Hertfordshire (A10 Great Cambridge Road, Cheshunt) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2009" and shall come into operation on Monday 18 January 2010.
2. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on those lengths of A10 Great Cambridge Road, Cheshunt as specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The provisions of the following Orders are hereby revoked;

The A10 Trunk Road (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1986
The A10 Trunk Road (Great Cambridge Road, Cheshunt, Hertfordshire) (40 miles per hour Speed Limit) Order 2004
The Hertfordshire (A10 Great Cambridge Road, Northbound, Cheshunt) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2007
4. The provisions of the following Order are hereby revoked but only in so far as they are affected by the restrictions imposed by this Order;

The London Traffic (40mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Regulations 1958
The Hertfordshire (A10 Great Cambridge Road and Halfhide Lane Roundabout, Turnford and Cheshunt) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2008
5. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

| Great Cambridge Road
(Northbound) | from its junction with the A10 Flamstead End Roundabout northwards for approximately 2660 metres to a point 10 metres north of a point in line with the projected north kerbline of Brookfield Lane West. |
| (Southbound) | from a point 45 metres south of a point in line with the projected north kerbline of Brookfield Lane West southwards for approximately 1650 metres to a point 55 metres south of a point in line with the projected south kerbline of Farm Close. |
