**Freedom of Information Request: 052/2010**

Thank you for your request received by the Council 9 February 2010.

Your enquiry was:

“Can you please provide by email details of residential property addresses (Just addresses not personal names) with BR8 postcodes where a current Council Tax Notice Of Exemption is in force”

The Council's response:

*Sevenoaks District Council can confirm that it holds this information.*

*Unfortunately the information is considered exempt under Section 40 of the Freedom of Information Act, 2000 as the release of private addresses could potentially breach Principles 1 & 2 of the Data Protection Act 1984.*

*Furthermore this information is exempt under section 31 of the Freedom of Information Act, 2000 as the release of the information could prejudice the physical security of the properties named.*

*I can, however, confirm that there are 173 properties within this postal code where a current Council Tax Notice of Exemption is in force.*
