

(DESIGNATION) ORDER, 1959

IN pursuance of Section 87 of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, the National Parks Commission hereby designate as an area of outstanding natural beauty for the purposes of the said Act, all that area of land comprising approximately 40 square miles situated in the Counties of Gloucester, Hereford, and Worcester and shown bounded by a dark green line edged internally by a broad light green band on the map annexed hereto.

This Order may be cited as the Malvern Hills Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (Designation) Order, 1959.
