
As Director of Consol Suncenter, I noted, with interest, a response to a parliamentary question which highlighted that the Health and Safety Executive will be publishing a consultation which is looking to amend current Health and Safety guidelines regarding tanning salons.

As the leading operator of partially staffed tanning salons – Consol operates 86 salons across the UK, including Scotland - we were surprised to learn that other stakeholders, such as The Sunbed Association, have been included in discussions regarding the consultation for a number of months. We would very much like to meet with you prior to the publication of the consultation to discuss any issues or queries regarding partially staffed salons which may be raised.

We feel it would be beneficial to involve individual operators more directly as The Sunbed Association is not representative of the overall industry, with less than 20% of salons holding membership. Further to this, The Sunbed Association do not have any members who operate partially staffed salons, consequently your discussions may not have included the high standards of operation employed by Consol.
