I am writing further to your e-mail of 3 July sent via 'Whatdotheyknow.com' to the Cabinet Office. Your e-mail has not been handled as a freedom of information request.

The Prime Minister's Office has no responsibility for handling the complaints you raise about the Police or the IPCC's handling of an individual complaint.

You should also be aware that the Freedom of Information Act allows requestors access only to information that is held by the public authority to whom the request is submitted. It creates no requirement for a Public Authority to create information for the purposes of answering a request. As you have previously been informed, this Office holds no information relevant to your request other than the correspondence that you have sent in.

Further correspondence on this matter will not be entered into to.
