You asked for –

...the program objects and their aliases and their associated monetary values from the COINS database.

The information you have requested is not available in the form you have stated, as monetary values are not related solely to programme objects. Information on programme objects themselves and their descriptions were provided to you earlier in March in response to your request of 9 February (your reference request-28590-5f879ce7@whatdotheyknow.com, our reference IRU/10/118).

If you were to refine your request to make it more specific, it may be that the information requested may be held in the form requested. However, in the event that such a search was possible within cost limits, it may be that exemptions under the Act may be engaged.
