We are handling your request under normal business processes, which means we are not handling your request in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act.

Please find attached figures 1.2b to 1.2 e which are taken from the Environmental Statement which show the extent of the climbing lanes.


During peak periods we will maintain three narrow lanes in both directions. There will however be some off peak closures overnight.
