*I am aware of the other data at the site <http://www.admin.cam.ac.uk/reporter/2007...> , specifically tables 4.2 and 4.3. These break down applications and acceptances by subject and school type OR subject and gender, they do not allow comparison between school types and gender.*

*Please could you send the corresponding information in for admissions 2008, 2006 and 2005 and any earlier years available.”*

Please also note:

1. As in table 1.2 of the Cambridge University Reporter 2007/8 No 14, the data is for ‘Home’ applications and acceptances. ‘Home’ is defined as applicants in the UCAS residential categories A, B, C, D and G (that is all categories except O).
2. The category ‘Other’ schools includes applicants from schools/colleges of an unknown school type and non-UK schools/colleges.
