Dear Mr McCall,

Thank you for your email to the Home Office on 10 December where you complained about not receiving a response to your earlier request and then replicated your request where you ask for "the brief or purpose of the National Attendance Management Forum".

In relation to your earlier request, I have checked through our records and could find no trace of it having been received by the Home office.

I have also conducted a search for any documents related to the National Attendance Management Forum. Unfortunately at this stage I could not find any information.

Section 1(3) of the Freedom of Information Act provides that a public authority need not comply with a request for information unless any further information reasonably required to identify and locate the information is supplied. I am unclear about the exact scope of the information in which you are interested.

To ensure that we provide you with the right information, I would be grateful if you could please provide us with more information about what the National Attendance Management Forum is to help clarify your request, as required by the Act.

When you provide this information we will aim to send you a full response to your request within twenty working days of its receipt. I look forward to hearing from you shortly. However please note that if I do not receive appropriate clarification of your request within three months from the date of this letter, I will consider this request to be closed.
