FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002 (FOISA)

Further to your email dated, 20 August 2010, requesting information under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002, I can advise you as follows:

Fife Constabulary's revenue funding for 2010/2011 was approved at £61.49 million, which is made up of £30.561 million from a police specific grant received from the Scottish Government and the balance of £30.93 million is met from the Police Authority. Fife Constabulary's capital funding for 2010/2011 was approved at £1.679 million.

If you are not satisfied with the way in which your request has been dealt with, you are entitled, in the first instance, to request a review of the decision made by the Force. Should you wish to request such a review, please write to me within 40 working days of receiving this letter. If, after having been informed of the review panel's decision, you are still not satisfied, you are then entitled to apply to the Scottish Information Commissioner for a decision within six months of the date of receipt of the review response.
