Re: Your Appeal under the Freedom of Information Act

I write further to your e-mail dated 8th January 2009 in which you made appeal against the original decision made into your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act by Vangie Parker.

You made a request on the 12th December 2008 under the Act for all information held by the IPCC about you and the complaints that you have made to the IPCC against Dyfed Powys Police.

Ms Parker replied to your request on the 8th January 2009. She advised you that the information requested was exempt under s40(1) of the Freedom of Information Act as it was considered to be personal data, and therefore not releasable under the Act.

She further advised you in the same letter to make a subject access request under the Data Protection Act.

I have considered the steps taken by Ms Parker and confirm that they were correct; therefore your appeal is not upheld.

I realise that this may not be the answer that you were hoping for, however, you can contact the Information Commissioners Office (ICO) now and complain to them about this decision if you so wish.
