Thank you for your further letter of 9 April about an e-petition and seeking "*clarification then in relation to the Department Of Communities and Local Government*".

Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the Act).

Under section 14(1) of the Act a public authority is not obliged to comply with a request it considers to be vexatious. We consider that section 14(1) applies to your request. As stated in our previous correspondence, the Prime Minister's Office does not hold the information you have requested. We have sought to be helpful by providing you with a contact address at the Department for Communities and Local Government should you wish to write to it to establish what information, if any, it holds.

We shall therefore not be progressing any further requests from you on this issue.
