**REQUEST FOR REVIEW OF FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST REFERENCE NO. 4395 – FIT FOR FUTURE BACKGROUND PAPERS**

I refer to your e-mail received on 8 April. You sought a review of a response which you had received in respect of your original Freedom of Information request. In that original request you asked for the Development Appraisal in the Fit for Future file referred to as background papers to the Council Report "Rationalisation of Office Accommodation Fit For Future Project 30 June 2005".

On 21 January the Department of City Development sent you a response and the documentation that was on file at the time of the Council Report. An e-mail copy of that response was sent to you on 27 February. It was explained to you that the full Development Appraisal was created and held electronically by the Council's advisers, Cushman and Wakefield, and was not held by the Council. You were sent an extract thereof which was the information held on file as at 30 June 2005.

It has been confirmed that that was indeed the position. You have been provided with all the information falling within your request.

The Council did receive a full Development Appraisal in September 2005, but this does not fall within the terms of your request. In the event of your requesting that document, such request will be considered by the Department of City Development.

In the above circumstances I am satisfied that your request was properly dealt with.
