Helianthemum nummularium – Common Rock-rose

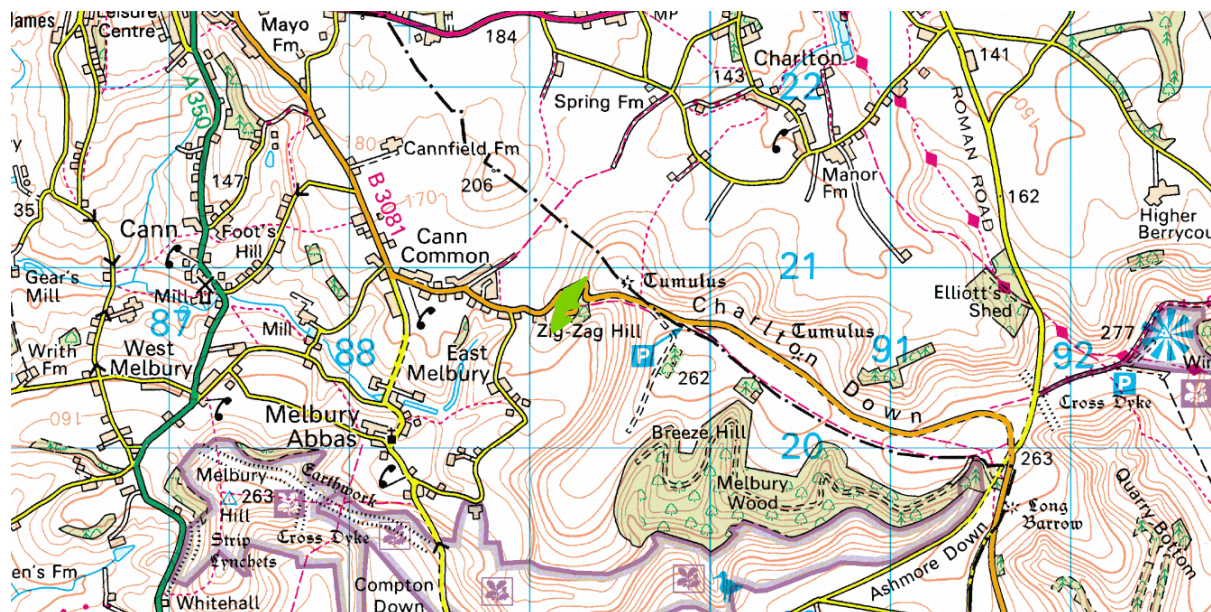
CUTTING PRESCRIPTION:

Avoid cutting between end May - end July.

Would benefit from early cut in April and late cut in August, occasionally, right back to prevent shrubs establishing on grassy island next to wood.

OTHER POINTS OF INTEREST:

- Roadside verge with chalk grassland flora – main area of interest on grassy island of second bend
