Dactylorhiza fuchsii – Common Spotted Orchid (appeared in 1988)

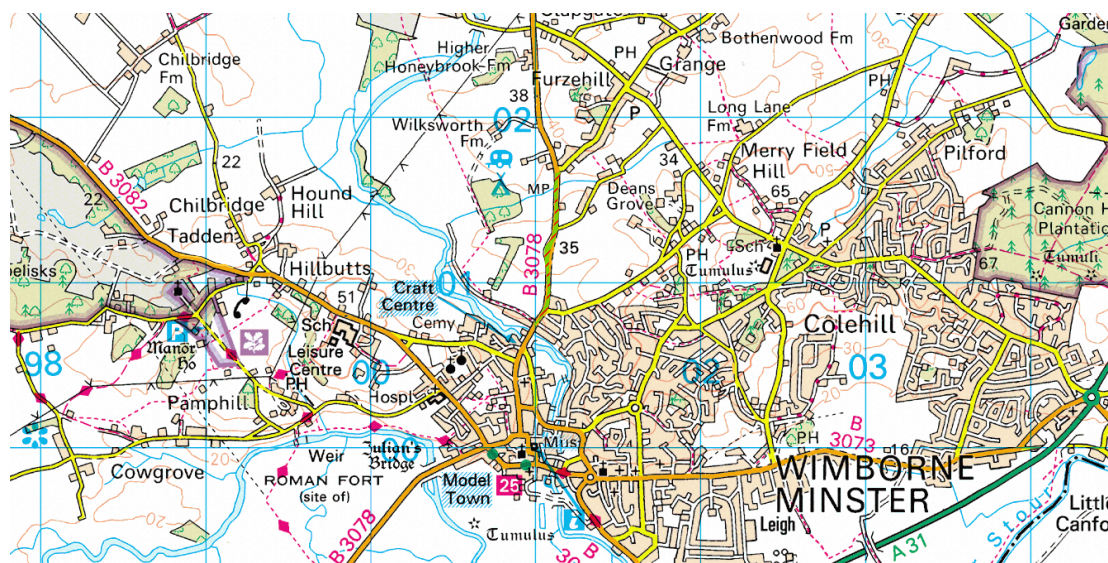
CUTTING PRESCRIPTION:

Avoid cutting between end of June – September.

Could be cut twice – very early in June and in the autumn to be beneficial to all species present.

OTHER POINTS OF INTEREST:

- Surveyed for SNCI – status withdrawn.
- Verge appears to be improving but may need early cut every third year.
- An area of roadside verge on chalk with a varied grassland flora
- Good hay meadow therefore needs cutting
- Pavement put in on East verge
