David,

As discussed a few weeks ago, although the BBC, and now Arqiva, have agreed amendments to our multiplex licenses which permit the transport of compressed SI data, BBC Free to view Ltd has not yet received the letter setting out the conditions of Ofcom's approval (wording proposed in Annex 1 of the consultation statement).

It would be reassuring if this action could be discharged in the next few days, prior to the first transmission of compressed SI data on Multiplexes 1, 2, A, C and D, which we expect to start on 21 September.
