Cut-through access: Gresham Road - Gonville Place, Cambridge

I'm writing for clarification of the cut-through between Gresham Road and A603/Gonville Place, both within the city of Cambridge. Are motor vehicles (motor vehicles wide enough to fit physically through the bollards) permitted to drive through said cut-through?

Gresham Road Limited Access Restriction can be found in appendix 1 as follows:

Affected Street - Schedule 19 Part 1, page 293

Exempted/Permitted Vehicles - Section 19, Articles 140 to 143, pages 61 to 63
