Dear Ms Sedelnikova,

Your request was received on 21 September 2017 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').

You asked:

*I am requesting the data for Computer Science applicants taking the Abitur from 2014 onwards.  
Please add the following information:*

- College*
- Predicted grades*
- CSAT Score*
- Interview score in each section*
- If an offer was made, which offer?*

This information is attached insofar as it is held. The University does not hold any information about interview scores as this aspect of the admissions process is handled by the individual Colleges, each of which is separate legal entity and public authority under the Act. Other omissions in the dataset are explained in the notes. In addition, the University has not supplied the year of each applicant because, coupled with the other information, it believes that individuals could be identified as a result. In presenting the information in this way, the University is engaging the exemption at section 40(3)(a)(i) of the Act because its release would breach the first data protection principle (the fair and lawful processing of personal data) as set out in Schedule 1 of the Data Protection Act 1998. This part of section 40 confers absolute exemption under the Act.
