The total number of successful applicants receiving a place on the Policy Advisor, Treasury Graduate Scheme 2017/18 from working class backgrounds (i.e. whose parents work in routine or manual work.)

The total number of applications made to the Policy Advisor, Treasury Graduate Scheme 2017/18 by individuals whose parents work in senior managerial, administrative or professional occupation.

The total number of successful applicants receiving a place on the Policy Advisor, Treasury Graduate Scheme 2017/18 whose parents work in senior managerial, administrative or professional occupation.

The total number of successful applicants receiving a place on the Policy Advisor, Treasury Graduate Scheme 2017/18 whose attended a fee paying school."

I can confirm that HM Treasury does hold some information within the scope of your request.

The total number of applications received for the HM Treasury Graduate Development Programme 2017/18 was 3,446. I am unable to comment on the number of successful candidates as the selection process is still ongoing. HM Treasury do not hold any further information within the scope of your request.
