Please note the following regarding the data:

1. Course transfers were only identified where a PLNC (plan (i.e. course) change) code could identify this in the University of Cambridge student record system, CamSIS: consequently, if a plan was changed, and this was not identifiable in CamSIS with a PLNC code, then this would not have been returned.
2. Data are for students admitted to the Land Economy Tripos, who transferred to another Tripos.
3. The five years taken related to years of admission only: a student may have transferred to another Tripos from Land Economy in 2018-19.
4. The Management Studies Tripos consists of only one part, the official title of which in CamSIS is 'Management Studies Tripos', hence why no specific part is identified for these records.
