Decision:

After carefully considering your request, the Council has decided to refuse to disclose some of the information you have asked for under Section 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

Basis for decision:

This law allows us to refuse to disclose personal information where to do so would either contravene any of the Data Protection Principles or would be likely to cause damage or distress to the person the information is about. This is called an "exemption".

Why does the exemption apply in this case?:

Personal information.

40. - (2) Any information to which a request for information relates is also exempt information if-

- (a) it constitutes personal data which does not fall within subsection (1), and
- (b) either the first, second or third condition below is satisfied.
- (3) The first condition is –

(a) the first condition is that the disclosure of the information to a member of the public otherwise than under this Act –

a. would contravene any of the data protection principles, or

b. would do so if the exemptions in section 24(1) of the Data Protection Act 2018 (manual unstructured data held by public authorities) were disregarded.

(3B)The second condition is that the disclosure of the information to a member of the public otherwise than under this Act would contravene Article 21 of the GDPR (general processing: right to object to processing).

(4A)The third condition is that—

(a)on a request under Article 15(1) of the GDPR (general processing: right of access by the data subject) for access to personal data, the information would be withheld in reliance on provision made by or under section 15, 16 or 26 of, or Schedule 2, 3 or 4 to, the Data Protection Act 2018, or

(b)on a request under section 45(1)(b) of that Act (law enforcement processing: right of access by the data subject), the information would be withheld in reliance on subsection (4) of that section

The information requested relates to individuals. Part 1 (3) (2) of the Data Protection Act 2018 defines personal data as any information relating to an identified or identifiable living individual.

Thus the Council believes that the disclosure of this information would contravene the Data Protection Act and specifically the first data protection condition in that it could cause distress to individuals who have a reasonable expectation that their personal data will remain confidential.

Therefore information about staff below head of service level has not been provided as it falls under this exemption.
