Thank you for your request of 21 March 2020 in which you asked for the following information:

As I have made several posts through FixMyStreet for the unblocking of road gullies directly outside my house to no avail I would like to know how much of my Council Tax is paid to Oxford County Council for Highway Maintenance and transport.

In total 9% of the Oxfordshire County Council element of your Council Tax bill goes towards expenditure on Highway Maintenance and Transport. Therefore, depending on the Council Tax band of your home, the total amount of your Council Tax bill which goes towards funding Highway Maintenance and Transport expenditure is as follows:

Band C	£122.19
Band D	£137.47
Band E	£168.02
Band F	£198.57
Band G	£229.12
Band H	£274.94
