Dear Rohan Singhal,

Your request was received on 5 April 2020 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').

You asked:

I would like to know the mean NSAA score (2018/19) for paper 1 (out of 54) and paper 2 (out of 40): for the applicants, and for those who were shortlisted.

This information is attached insofar as it is held. The University does not know 'shortlisted' applicants as this aspect of the admissions process is handled by the individual Cambridge Colleges, each of which is a separate legal entity and public authority under the Act. We have instead supplied offer-holder data alongside that for all applicants.
