Your request was received on 2 July 2020 and I am dealing with it under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('the Act').

You asked:

Please may you provide the following in a excel spreadsheet for the years 19/20 and 20/21 for the course MPhil in Finance and Economics:

- 1) Total number of applicants for each year with a note of how many of the applicants have studied in China for their undergraduate degree.*
- 2) Total number of offers for each year with a note of how many of the offer holders have studied in China for their undergraduate degree.*
- 3) Applicants for each year broken down by the university they have attended for undergraduate study (tallying the total number of applicants from each higher education institution eg. Leeds: 5, Renmin University of China:20 ... etc)*
- 4) Offer holders for each year broken down by the university they have attended for undergraduate study (tallying the total number of offer holders from each higher education institution eg. Leeds: 1, Renmin University of China: 2 ... etc*
