Thank you for your enquiry of 9 September 2020, which we have considered under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOI Act).

You asked for the following information:

“Please provide, since 01/01/2014, all consultation, approaches and records relating to losses and write-offs involving Highway England (formerly the Highways Agency) following damage to Crown property (DCP) events.”
