Freedom of Information request – RFI20202013

Thank you for your request to the BBC of 23 December 2020 seeking the following information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000:

“I would appreciate it if you could let me know how much the BBC has spent developing britbox and where that money came from to enable the BBC to develop such things.”

We have interpreted your request to refer to BritBox UK. BritBox is a joint commercial venture between ITV and the BBC. ITV will own 90% of the new BritBox service and the BBC's initial 10% stake could rise to 25% in the future. The BBC's 10% stake is held by BBC Commercial Holdings.

As set out in section 6(1)(b)(ii) of the Act, our subsidiaries (including BBC Studioworks Limited, UKTV, BBC Global News Ltd and BBC Studios Ltd), as well as the charities BBC Media Action and BBC Children in Need, are not subject to the Act. Therefore information regarding their activities is also not subject to the Act.

Appeal Rights

If you are not satisfied that we have complied with the Act in responding to your request, you have the right to an internal review by a BBC senior manager or legal adviser. A request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of receiving the BBC's response to your original request.
