I have got the code running on the Apache web server and am able to use it fine. However, you said and I quote, that you provided files necessary "to understand and implement the Barley source code." The "doc" directory appears to be missing as per readme.txt.

We believe that in our internal review response of 11 September 2017, we provided you with sufficient information to fulfil your request for information.
